



February 17, 2019 – Cape Town City Tour

- Situated below Table Mountain, Devil's Peak and Lion's Head, Cape Town offers a rich cultural and

industrial heritage, grand splendor and an assurance of activity of excitement at the V&A Waterfront. Including all the `must-sees` of any Cape Town day tour, this option is a geographical and cultural extravaganza, showing you Cape Town, from its historical beginnings to the dazzling modern shopping malls of the Victoria and Alfred Waterfront. February 19, 2019 - Robben Island Tour - (Afrikaans: Robbeneiland) is an island in Table Bay 4.3 mi west of the coast of Bloubergstrand, Cape Town, South Africa. Forget palm trees and sun-kissed beaches; Robben Island's allure lies in its rich and wretched history.



South Africa's first democratically elected president – Nelson Mandela – spent 18 years of his 27 years in prison on Robben Island.

Easily the most famous of the island's political prisoners, Mandela was by no means the island's only notable inmate – South African presidents Kgalema Motlanthe and Jacob Zuma also spent time there. Depart for Robben island today at 2:15pm. 4-5 hour tour, including travel. Cost \$80.00 per person.

February 20, 2019 - Cape Point - The mother of all scenic tours in South Africa. On this Cape of Good Hope Tour we will show you the The Fairest Cape...and it surely is! You'll soon see for yourself where and why it earned its name.

We start our Cape of Good Hope Tour by you sitting back and relaxing, as we cruise along the exquisite stretch of coastline known as Millionaire's Paradise – from

Camps Bay and Clifton to the exclusive beach hamlet of Llandudno - towards the charming working harbor of Hout Bay. Thereafter, we wind along the legendary Chapman's Peak Drive, hugging the cliffs and relishing the breath taking ocean views, before arriving at our lunch spot of choice (own account): the wild and beautiful Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve, an integral part of the world-renowned Cape Floral Kingdom.

Then it's on to **Cape Point** where (by tradition) two marine ecosystems and oceans meet. Here you will experience the grandeur of one of the highest sea cliffs in the world, the drama of the two mighty oceans meeting to become one, the scenic splendor, intriguing history and abundant visitor attractions of the Cape of Good Hope at the south-western most tip of Africa. You have the choice; either walk up to the point or ride the funicular. After lunch, the coach moves through to Boulders Beach, which is home to a growing colony of the vulnerable, "African Jackass Penguin," which may easily be viewed at close quarters from the boardwalk. February 21 – Table Mountain, City Tour and Shopping

Tour - Take a trip up to Table Mountain in the world famous cable car! On top of the mountain you will be able to see all the way down to the Cape Point Reserve. The views from the top of this mountain are of the best in the world and certainly the best in the Cape. Next, take a brief tour of the Cape Town. Learn a little about the history and culture of the Cape. Continue with stops at the Green Market and Victoria and Alfred Square.

First stop Stellenbosch; a town in the Western Cape province of South Africa, situated about 50 kilometres (31 miles) east of Cape Town, along the banks of the Eerste River at the foot of the Stellenbosch Mountain. It is the second oldest European settlement in the province, after Cape Town. The town became known as the City of Oaks or Eikestad in Afrikaans and Dutch due to the large number of oak trees that were planted by its founder, Simon van der Stel, to grace the streets and homesteads. Departure at 10:30 am. All day program. Cost \$155.00 per person. Lunch is included.

February 22, 2019 – Dinner at The Gold's Restaurant -
