If these items are moveable, you can make a display, and if not, you can take and print pictures or video the items. *Be sure to get permission from an adult family member!* They may even help you! Create a name for your "family history museum," and have your mom and dad (or grandpa and grandma or other family members) tell you stories about the items. Remember to have someone record the stories as they are told. You could also do a show and tell via Zoom and maybe your house shows and tells and then another house (maybe your cousin's or some other family member's or a friend's) can share about their family.
